 - b. How does the prophecy of 3:15 shed light on what we read in Genesis 4-5 and the rest of the Bible?

 - c. Why is it important to understand this if we are going to profit from the Bible?

2. Take another look at Genesis 4:1-2. Why does Eve seem so excited about Cain's birth?

3. Based on 4:2-7, why do you think God rejected Cain's offering? (ref: Psalm 51:15-17.)
 - a. How does Cain take the rejection?

4. How does Hebrews 11:4 shed light on the difference between the sacrifices of Cain and Abel?
 - a. How does Genesis 3:15 shed light on the difference?

5. Read Genesis 4:6-7, 9. What do we learn about God as we see him asking questions? (See Genesis 3:9-11.)
