REVIEW

- 1. Was there anything from this past Sunday's message that challenged or confused you?

- 2. David different than the man Samuel expected to be anointed king? Describe a time in your life where you expected one thing but God delivered in unexpected ways.

DIGGING DEEPER

1.	Earlier in the book of 1 Samuel, Samuel had been commanded by God to anoint Saul to be King of Israel (see 1 Samuel 9:15-10:24). What did Samuel think of Saul? (see 10:24)
	a. How did the people feel about him as King?
2.	Samuel is sent to Jesse because God has chosen one of his sons to be the next King of Israel. Why does he think Eliab is the chosen one?
3.	What lesson does God offer in v.7? How does God evaluate men and women?
	a. Is it possible for us to apply v.7 to how we interact with the people in our own lives? Explain.
4.	Take a few moments to read 1 Corinthians 1:26-31. How do these verses apply to David?
	a. How might these verses apply to you and what God is calling you to do?
5.	Read Isaiah 53:2-6. What similarities do you see between God's choice of David as king and God's choice of Jesus as King?
