- **2.** Pilate describes Jesus as "King of the Jews." In what ways is this title correct and appropriate?
 - **a.** In what ways is it incorrect and inappropriate?
- 3. From the verses about Jesus' trial, a good deal can be implied about the character of Pilate. But what do we actually know about Pilate? What details can we learn from parallel accounts, or from Sunday's sermon?
- **4.** Based on Mark's account, who do you think bore the greater responsibility: the Jewish leaders (Sanhedrin) or the Roman court (Pilate)?
 - **a.** Do you think it matters who is to blame?
