 - a. Have you personally struggled with the notion of Christian exclusivity?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. Read the following verses out loud. Romans 10:9, Hebrews 9:28, 1 John 5:5, Acts 4:12, and John 14:6. Through the New Testament we consistently hear a claim that salvation comes from no one but Jesus. How do you think Christians should strike a balance between confidence in God's Word and respectful humility in their interactions with people who disagree?
- 2. Whether agnostic, atheist, or faith-based all religious viewpoints make some type of exclusive claim. And most world religions have a stance on Jesus that

he was only a prophet, or that he was a good man, or that he was a wise teacher. Read John 3:16-18. How do you think Christians can best take this passage seriously in light of the alternate views of Jesus?

- a. How should a Christian message address the ideas of salvation and condemnation?
- 3. God created us, we fell into sin, he has redeemed us creation, fall, redemption. How could these three concepts give people a powerful basis to treat with respect and justice those with whom they deeply differ?¹
