 - a. How can we as believers celebrate the God who promises impossible things?**
 - b. In what specific ways can we live as one family with all those who share the faith and hope depicted in this chapter?**

a. How does this passage show us we are secure?

b. Who can effectively be against us if God is with us? Why?

c. What does God sending his son tell us about how God will take care of us? Why are we sometimes tempted to forget that?
