REVIEW

1. Was there anything from this past Sunday's message that challenged or confused you?
2. Can you think of one thing from Sunday's sermon that you are likely to remember two weeks from now?

MY STORY

1. This week we learned about Abraham's call from God. Think back to your faith journey, was there ever a time when you clearly sensed the call of God in your life? What was that time like? What happened as a result of the call?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Read Genesis 11:27-32 and Acts 7:2-4. What do we learn about Abram's call?
 - a. What do we learn about his family situation?
2. Read Genesis 12:1-3. Consider the call to Abraham. What does God ask of him?
 - a. In what ways do we have to answer this same call? (See Galatians 3:8-9.)
3. Read Genesis 12:1-7. Continue to analyze the call to Abraham.
 - a. What does God promise him?
 - b. Verse 7. What is the one promise needed to make all the other promises come true?
4. In the creation account in Genesis we find out that God exiled Adam and Eve from Eden, increased the pain of childbirth, cursed the ground so that it would produce food only through hard labor,

and ordained that humans would not live forever. How do God's promises to Abram in (Gen. 12:1-3) begin to address the components of the curse in Genesis 3?

- a. How do the promises to Abram begin to anticipate the redemption that would come through Jesus?
