3. vv.25 Look at two or three translations for the word Paul uses to describe Jesus' sacrifice in v.25a. Now look up the word "propitiation" in a dictionary. What does this word tell us about what Jesus death did for us?
 - a. Does this word depict God as a "blood-thirsty" God without any love?
4. How can Jesus' "atoning sacrifice" make God both "just" AND "the one who justifies" those who believe?
5. Paul says the gospel excludes boasting (v.27). How does it do that? How has it excluded boasting in you?
